WORKSHOP OF THE LAKE CITY COUNCIL

May 24, 2012

The meeting was opened at 9:35 AM with a motion made by Councilman Ginn and seconded by Councilman Williams.

A discussion embraced the proposed rules of the new community center which was scheduled to open on or about June 18, 2012. After discussing more than 37 different rules it was concluded that the Manager would prepare a digested final work product to be presented to the Council with an Enabling Resolution at its June 11, 2012 Council Meeting.

The Rules and Regulations for the Oswalt Nature Park were discussed briefly as they were previously approved at a work shop in November 2011. The Manager alerted the Council that he would present an Enabling Resolution together with these rules for passage at the June 11, 2012 Council Meeting

The issue of back filling a vacated patrol officer position was presented by the Manager together with exhibits illustrating that ticket revenue effectively offsets the cost of hire. A motion to hire was made by Councilwomen Kelly, seconded by Councilman Williams. Council Members Kelly, Williams and Sowell voted yes and Councilman Ginn voted no.

A brief update on Public Works activities was offered by Eddie Robinson.

A motion to adjourn the meeting at 11:25 AM was made by Councilman Sowell and seconded by Councilwoman Kelly. The motion passed unanimously.
