Regular Meeting Minutes

Attendees: **Mayor Pro Tem Kelly, Councilman Sowell, Councilman Ginn, Public Works Superintendent Robinson, Chief Colwell, Capt. H. Simmons, Finance Clerk T. Tripp and Intern Tim Hoyle.**

The work session commenced at 6:00 PM Mrs. Tripp went over the meeting agenda with members.

Chief Colwell spoke to the Council about the monthly police report and about the new laws that were coming in effect this year.

Chief Colwell presented Capt. Harold Simmons with a proclamation from the City. On behave of his dedication to continuation of his education.

Chief Colwell read his monthly police report to the Councilmember's.

Public Works Superintendent Robinson brought the Council up to date on the status of several Public Works projects. (Sidewalk repairs, Sewer project, Abandoned commercial Property Project and the status on the Community Center Construction Project.

Other business: Citizen Bill Mitchell asked about why the City didn't fly any flags on the street light poles on Hwy 54 anymore on Holidays. Public Works Dir. Robinson explained that the flags were in to bad of shape for us to put out and new ones were not budgeted for this year. Mr. Mitchell requested that the City purchase new flags for the street light poles down Hwy 54. Councilman Sowell made a motion to purchase new flags for hwy 54, seconded by Councilman Ginn. The measure passed unanimously.

There being no further business, Councilman Sowell made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Councilman Ginn. The measure passed unanimously. The meeting ended at 7:25PM.
