Approval of Minutes, motion made by Councilman Sowell seconded by Councilman Ginn, motion passed unanimously.

The Mayor presented a proclamation to Hazel Dorminy for her 100th birthday celebration and the Chief presented a proclamation to Sgt. George Fine for 20 years of service with the City of Lake City.

City Manager Reports

A motion was made by Councilwoman Kelly, seconded by Councilman Ginn and unanimously appointing Billy and Virginia Williams as Poll Managers for the City election November 2013 with the understanding that an official resolution would be adopted after September 2013 if candidates are qualified to run for election and that resolution will also contain the fees and training costs for Mr. and Mrs. Williams and their poll workers if applicable.

Bid award to A & A Door Company for City Hall and Police Department door locks was presented by the Director of Community Services. Motion made by Councilman Ginn, seconded by Councilman Williams, and the motion passed unanimously.

The City Manager asked for a re a-affirmation of the following Administrative Goals since these activities will involve a great deal of work over an extended period of time. The Manager wanted to make sure that the entire City Council wanted to proceed without hesitation on these new initiatives as a means to move forward with economic redevelopment in the City. The entire council expressed their desire to move ahead with these programs.

1. Creation of a Merchants Committee comprising of 6 members
2. Code Enforcement Board Members consisting of 3 members

3. Appointment of DDA Board Members (yet to be named)
4. Creation of Opportunity Zone with the assistance of University of Georgia and CSU MBA Interns.

City Attorney Reports

City Attorney reported that he was scheduling a meeting with the property owners of the trailer park and their attorney and members of the City Administration next week to hopefully resolve certain outstanding issues regarding the use of that property.

Community Services Report

Community Services Director presented the attached report including an explanation of the proposed street sign configurations which will be presented again during the workshop session on May 23, 2013.

Police Department Report

The Police Chief presented the Council with the attached monthly report for activities during the month of April 2013 together with an explanation of the license trackers which have been installed on 3 police vehicles.
