SPECIAL SESSION

AGENDA- DISCUSSION TO DETERMINE STIPEND FOR ATTENDING ANNUAL GMA CONFERENCE. – It was moved by Bobby Williams, seconded by Dwight Ginn to reduce the stipend to \$300 from its present level of \$500. The measure passed unanimously. The City Attorney advised that an expense statement with receipts is necessary and any excess monies not spent from the advance must be returned to the City in accordance with State Law. Councilman Sowell went on record to reflect that he did not want an advance and so did Councilman Williams.

City Attorney reports

- a) **ref Trailer Park appeal hearing – The City Attorney advised that the hearing scheduled for June 26th will be for “instructional purposes” only since the appeal has been withdrawn by the property owners.**
- b) **LOST & SDS – The City Attorney requested two Resolutions which are cited below.
moved by Councilman Sowell, seconded by Councilwoman Kelly that Mayor Oswalt be authorized to sign documents approving the SDS plan for Clayton County, and affirmed by unanimous vote.**

moved by Councilman Sowell, seconded by Councilwoman Kelly that Mayor Oswalt be authorized to sign documents approving the LOST distribution for Clayton County, and affirmed by unanimous vote.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Councilwoman Kelly to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Councilman Williams and the measure passed unanimously.
