

# MINUTES

## WORK SHOP OF THE LAKE CITY COUNCIL

September 25, 2014

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**9:30AM**

**Participants: Mayor and Members of the City Council, City Manager, Director of Community Services, Police Chief**

### **New Business**

- a) Veterans plaque discussion – The Mayor suggested that Oswalt Nature Park be graced with a plaque honoring our veterans and to be a source of an additional dedication of the park on Veterans Day, November 11<sup>th</sup> 2014. The members of the council agreed with a unanimous vote of approval.
- b) Risk Assessment – It was agreed that the administration will present suggestions for employment contracts during the FY 2015 Budget Presentations this year.
- c) Tri City Resolution and update – The City Manager introduced a Resolution authorizing the City's Urban Redevelopment Agency which was similar to the ones already in existence at Forest Park and Morrow. This resolution is a necessary component of the Tri City Initiative which is in the last stages of preparation before it is presented to the DCA for approval. A motion was made by Councilman Williams, seconded by Councilman Ginn and the measure passed unanimously.

Old Business – The Director of Community Services produced three bids for the cutting of certain decayed trees within the right of way located at 5640 Reynolds Rd.

Bids: 1. Toby's Tree Service \$2,300 Quote date 09/15/2014  
2. Milam's Tree Service \$5,250 Quote date 09/16/2014  
3. King's Tree Experts \$3,000 Quote date 09/17/2014

It was recommended that Toby Tree Service be awarded the bid as it was the lowest of the three bids in the amount of \$2,300. A motion was made by Councilman Ginn, seconded by Councilman Williams and the measure passed unanimously.
