## **Meeting Minutes**

**March 14, 2016**

**Participants: Mayor and all Councilmembers, Interim City Manager, City Attorney and Police Chief**

### **6:00 PM Work Shop**

Interim City Manager advised council that the Public Works Department was in need of replacing the right of way mower. (2008 Scag) He advised that he had 4 bids on mowers and that Campbell's Hardware was willing to give the city a trade in value on the Scag of a \$1,000 dollars toward the purchase of a new mower. Motion was made by Councilmember Ginn and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilmember Hoover and a unanimous vote of yes to trade in old Scag to Campbell's Hardware on the purchase of a new Gravely PT148 mower sale price of \$6,660.42 without trade in value. To be paid for with the 2014 SPLOST funds.

Amending Sign Ordinance Article XVII of Chapter 42 (Zoning)

City Attorney advised Mayor and Councilmembers about the need to change the sign ordinance due to a new Supreme Court ruling on the content of signs.

Comment session was opened to public. Mrs. Wilson (resident) had a comment about Real estate signs and placement. She was advised by Interim City Manager about the ordinance regulations on real estate signs. No other comments were heard.

A motion was made by Councilmember Sowell and 2<sup>nd</sup> By Councilmember Ginn with a unanimous vote of yes to extend the sign moratorium to April 12 so that the city attorney could finish the new sign ordinance.

Motion was made by Councilmember Ginn and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilmember Hoover with a unanimous yes vote to adjourn the Zoning meeting.
