June 13, 2016

6:00 PM Workshop:

Erick Crawford from Turnkey Motors, LLC came before the Mayor and Council to discuss the use of gravel as a used car lot at 5481 North Parkway. Mr. Crawford was advised the owner of the property would need to file for a variance of the zoning code to be able to use the gravel as a parking lot.

Interim City Manager asked the Mayor and Council for clarification on the 3% across the board raise for employees that was approved at the May 26th workshop. Mayor and Council advised it was a cost of living raise for all current employees' retro back to January 1st, 2016. Minutes from the May 26th workshop will be amended to show raise as a cost of living raise.

Mayor and Council unanimously agreed the City should pay off the lease debts for the vehicles and LPRs.

Motion was made by Councilmember Sowell and 2nd by Councilmember Ginn with a unanimous vote of yes to approval the Ordinance to repeal the Lake City Vehicle for Hire ordinance Chapter 40 of the Lake City Code.
