Agenda Items:

Interim City Manager advised Mayor and Council that Billy Williams has accepted to be appointed the election Superintendent for the City of Lake City for the elections in 2017. And there would be a small cost increase for this service. A motion was made by Council Member Sowell and 2nd by Council Member Williams to appoint Billy Williams as election superintendent for 2017 elections. With a unanimous yes vote.

Interim City Manager advised Mayor and Council of the dates approved by the State to hold the special election to fill the seat of Dwight Ginn. Those dates were:

March 21, 2017 Election date
Feb. 27th-March 17th Advanced voting
Jan. 30th – Feb. 1st Qualifying

June 19, 2017 Election date
May 29th – June 16th Advanced voting
April 24th –April 26th Qualifying

Motion was made by Council Member Sowell to pick the March 21st 2017 election date. 2nd by Council Member Williams with a unanimous vote of yes.

Finance Officer Tripp had a discussion on setting the 2016 Millage rate for the City of Lake City. She advised the Mayor and Council of the public notice that would need to be placed in the local paper and also that three hearing dates would need to be set for the public. Attorney Fincher advised that the hearings needed to be done even though the millage rate was not being changed. (Dates and times of hearings were not known at this time).

Short discussion was held on the process of going over applications to fill the City Manager position.

Motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Williams and 2nd by Council Member Sowell with a unanimous vote of yes.
