Meeting called to order by Mayor Oswalt

New Business:

1. Financial Auditor Service Proposals. A motion was called by Mayor Oswalt to interview the five companies that submitted a bid to be the city's auditor. There was no second, therefore the motion did not carry. Councilmember Williams made a motion to maintain James Whitaker P.C. as the city's auditor. This motion was seconded by Councilmember Hoover and opposed by the Mayor. The motion was approved 2-1.
2. The 2017 Budget was presented by the City Manager. This was the first public discussion pertaining to the 2017 budget.
3. The City Attorney discussed a meeting pertaining to opposition to dividing Lake City into voting districts by the Clayton County Delegation.

Old Business:

1. The City Manager asked to have the City Attorney draft legislation to amend Article II of Chapter 24 of the City Code to comply with the requirements of HB 691 as it pertains to the appointment of Municipal Judges.
