WORK SESSION OF THE LAKE CITY COUNCIL

May 25th, 2017

Call to order: 9:30 AM

New Business:

1. A presentation was made to the Council by Nicole Hall representing Nickel Works Consulting. The presentation was pertaining to the proposed I75/Southlake Community Improvement District. She discussed the basics of how CID worked and presented a map of the area that would be included in the study. She asked the council if they would be willing to participate in the feasibility study by agreeing to pay one fourth of the cost which would be between \$10,000.00 to \$15,000.00. Miss Hall also stated she would be going to Forest Park at their next council meeting but the county and the City of Morrow had committed to the study. Councilmember Sowell did not feel the amount of money to be paid for the feasibility study should be divided equally as the other entities were larger than Lake City. This sentiment was held by Councilmembers Hoover and McDuffie as well. The council felt the amount should be pro-rated. There was no vote taken. Miss Hall stated she would follow up with the council.
2. The Finance Director Tonya Tripp presented a resolution to the council to amend the 2016 seized funds budget to comply with State Law. The motion to accept was made by Councilmember Hoover and seconded by Councilmember McDuffie. The motion was passed unanimously.

Old Business:

1. The Council discussed the changes of the wording of Article XVII (signs) of Chapter 42 (Zoning) of the Lake City Ordinances. The council was supportive and will vote at the next regular scheduled meeting of the council on June 12th, 2017.

Adjournment:

A motion to adjourn was made by Councilmember Hoover, seconded by Councilmember McDuffie. The motion passed unanimously. The work session ended at 1035.
