

# **REGULAR MEETING OF THE LAKE CITY COUNCIL**

## **MINUTES**

**March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

### **6:00 PM Work Session:**

Clayton County Fire Chief Landry Merkison briefed the Council on the Fire Station that will be built in Lake City by the county. Fire Chief Merkison presented an architectural drawing of Fire Station 15 to the council. In addition, Chief Merkison the ground breaking should take place this year and the construction should be completed in January – February 2019. Chief Merkison also told the council the County will connect the new Fire Station to the County sewer lines.

The City Manager gave an update to the council pertaining to the unfunded liability owed to city employees. The council was informed that checks would be given to affected employees on Friday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

The March work Session scheduled for March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2018 was cancelled.

The community clean up is scheduled for Saturday, April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018 from 8:00AM – 4:30 PM.

The Community Services Director briefed the council on SPLOST updates. There are several projects underway. First, several trees were cut down in Lake City Park. This is part of the renovation of the park. Second, the installation of the generator for city hall is underway. Third, the purchase of a Utility Vehicle for Public Works has been completed and will be delivered shortly. Another update to city hall is installation of LED lighting.
