## **MINUTES**

### **6:00 PM Work Session:**

1. The City Manager gave an update to the Christmas Tree Lighting. It will occur on November 17<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM.
2. Eddie Robinson gave an update to the work on the Community Center. B-Dry will be doing the work to mitigate the water and moisture that has damaged the floor to the community center.

The Council was then presented information by Dr. Beasley the Superintendent of the Clayton County Schools pertaining to the Clayton County Schools and the initiatives being implemented by Dr. Beasley and his team. In addition, Dr. Beasley stated the Grant Rate is improving and that 7 of the 11 High Schools had a graduation rate of over eighty percent.
