June 8th, 2020

6:30 PM Work Session:

1. The City Manager updated the Council on the 2021 SPLOST Intergovernmental Agreement.
2. Eddie Robinson the Community Affairs Director gave an update for the community cleanup. The date for the cleanup will be August 29th, 2020 from 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM. The shredder will be on site from 12:00 PM -3:00 PM. No tires will be accepted.
3. The City Manager presented a Revenue and Expenditure Statement that was prepared by the City Finance Director. It was a detailed report and as expected the city saw less revenue in April 2020 than it did in April 2019 because of the COVID-19 restrictions. In addition, May 2020 saw 3.83% less revenue than May 2019. Year to date the city is showing an overall positive \$65,565.78 in revenue over expenses.
4. The City Manager advised the council the city had been awarded a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in the amount of \$200,000.00. This will be available for disbursement after August 1st. This money is designated to purchase the playground equipment and other items for the Lake City Community Park.
5. The Paving project for Forest Parkway is scheduled to begin sometime in June and take approximately thirty days to complete depending on the weather.

This was not included on the initial agreement that was accepted by Resolution 2020-03.
2. The Mayor and Council presented awards to Eddie Robinson the Community Services Director and Assistant Police Chief Lieutenant Sherman Triplett for thirty years of service to the city.
